Submission of Papers:

Submissions to IIMA 2013 must not already have been published in a journal, presented at another conference, or be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere. All submissions will be reviewed by the track chairs, program committee and selected reviewers. All reviews are double blind. The editorial board will make the final determination whether the accepted papers are published in the IIMA 2013 Proceedings. The best papers of the conference will be sent to the Communications of the IIMA (CIIMA), a double blind, peer reviewed serial publication (ISSN: 1543-5970 print & ISSN: 1941-6687 on-line). There will be a *Best paper* award as well as a *Best Student paper* award at the conference.

Format of Submitted Papers:

Papers must follow the guidelines in the current Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA). The language of the conference and related publications is English. Each submitted paper must include an abstract and must conform to the following format: First Page: Title, author(s), address, phone, fax, email address, abstract. Second and subsequent pages: Title, full manuscript (limited to 25 double-spaced pages). Each accepted paper must be presented at the conference and be accompanied by paid registration. Accepted conference papers will be notified by June 1, 2013.

Please submit electronic copy in Word format through the www.iima.org web site. Any questions, please email the Conference Chair no later than Apr 15, 2013. Any submission received after the deadline, exceeds length requirements, or does not adhere to the format and APA guidelines will be rejected without review.
