Submissions for this conference must not have already been published in a journal, presented at another conference, nor be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere.

Full papers are up to 25 pages, including references and all appendices.Short papers are up to 8 papers, including references and all appendices.The (extended) abstract can range between 400 and a maximum of 1500 words.Review Process: All papers will be blind peer-reviewed to ensure academic integrity and relevance to the conference theme.

Papers must follow the guidelines in the current Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA). The language of the conference and related publications is English. Each submitted paper must include an abstract and must conform to the following format: First page: title, author(s), email address, institution, abstract. Second and subsequent pages: title, full manuscript (limited to 25 double-spaced pages). Each accepted paper must be presented at the conference and be accompanied by paid registration before being included and published in the IIMA 2025 Conference Proceedings.

Collaboration with IIMA Journals:

The best papers of the conference will be sent to the Communications of the IIMA (CIIMA), a double blind, peer-reviewed publication (ISSN: 1543-5970 print & ISSN: 1941-6687 online) (http://scholarworks.lib.csusb.edu/ciima/)
