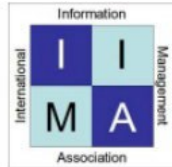

Submissions for this conference must not have already been published in a journal, presented at another conference, nor be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere.

Extended abstract, panel and workshop submission:	June 26, 2026 midnight AoE. - new due date!
Latest conference acceptance notification:	not later than July 13, 2026
Final version and conference fee payment by presenters due:	August 14, 2026

Full papers are up to 25 pages, including references and all appendices.

Short papers are up to 8 pages, including references and all appendices.

The (extended) abstract can range between 400 and a maximum of 1500 words.

Review Process: All papers will be peer-reviewed to ensure academic integrity and relevance to the conference theme.

Panel or Workshop Proposal:

To propose a panel or a workshop on any of the conference themes, contact the program chair member Nerko Hadziarapovic (nerko.hadziarapovic@hu.nl). For a panel, provide the session topic and a list of 3-5 potential panellists. For a workshop, provide a short description and outline (max 450 words) of the proposed workshop.

Papers

Papers must follow the guidelines in the current Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA). The language of the conference and related publications is English. Each submitted paper must include an abstract and must conform to the following format: First page: title, author(s), email address, institution, abstract. Second and subsequent pages: title, full manuscript (limited to 25 double-spaced pages). Each accepted paper must be presented at the conference and be accompanied by paid registration before being included and published in the IIMA 2026 Conference Proceedings. To ensure you follow these guidelines, [please use the IIMA Conference Paper Template](#). If you do not use the template, you may risk a desk rejection of your submitted paper.

Collaboration with IIMA Journals:
